(a) Carbon has three isotopes with different numbers of neutrons: carbon 12 (C 12, 6 protons + 6 neutrons), carbon 13 (C 13, 6 protons + 7 neutrons), and carbon 14 (C 14, 6 protons + 8 neutrons).C 12 and C 13 are stable.
